



7 SOLUTIONS FOR DISPLAYING COLLECTIBLES

1. **FOLLOW THE SEASONS:** Bring out certain collectibles only at certain times of the year. Your snow globes adorn the shelves in winter, your shell collection comes out during the summer months.
2. **ROTATE:** Display only half of the collection at a time so it doesn't overwhelm. You'll enjoy the pieces you haven't seen in a while.
3. **GO VERTICAL:** Use a tall bookshelf to maximize display space. Hang items from the walls on hooks.
4. **GO EVEN HIGHER:** Run a shelf along the perimeter of the room in the space rarely used (about 18 inches from the ceiling).
5. **USE IT:** Find creative uses for your collection. Make a bulletin board out of used wine corks. (there are kits for this!)
6. **DOUBLE DUTY:** Display your postcard collection inside the vintage frames you also collect. Fill your precious glass vases with multi-colored beads.
7. **GET CRAFTY:** Use fabric from your overseas vacation to make pillow covers. Sew rarely worn t-shirts into a quilt (there are companies that specialize in this service).
